The Ky Hurst Mini Swim is a swim of approximately 800 metres to 1 km depending on conditions. The course will start on the beach at a point west of The Pass and will finish in front of the Surf Club.

Costs

Entry fee – Online, Mail & In Person:

- 9 – 15 years - \$15
- 16 – 74 years - \$30
- 75+ years - Free
- Family - 2 adults and 2 school age children - \$90

Entry fee includes event baseball cap & swim cap.

Cancellation

The Race Committee reserves the right to cancel the race due to rough or dangerous seas. In the event of cancellation (by either party) there will be no refund of Entry Fee.

Check-in

The Surf Club, Byron Bay, on Sunday May 6, 2018 from 7am. Check-in closes at 8am to give you time to walk to the Race Start.

Race Start

Staggered from 8:45am at The Pass area. Beach or water start depending on conditions on the day.

Prizes

Medals will be awarded for the first boy and girl aged 9, 10, 11, or 12 on the day.

You are welcome to swim but no prizes or places will be awarded to swimmers wearing neoprene wetsuits, flotation devices, fins, or other swimming aids.

Ruling on Hi-Tech Swim Suits

To be eligible for prizes and placings, swimmers must wear only conventional swimming costumes made from Lycra and/or nylon and/or polyester. Costumes must contain no neoprene or any other 'high-tech' material or substance or any material with any flotation support. Male swimmers must wear only briefs with no arms, legs or any part of the costume covering their body above the waist. Female swimmers must wear either one or two piece costumes with no arms or legs. It does not preclude "rashies" worn or any material with for protection from the sun and/or stingers, provided they are not made from neoprene or any other "high-tech" material or substance any flotation support.

Conditions of Entry

The Entrant/Parent/Guardian of the Entrant named overleaf, in consideration of the acceptance by Byron Bay Winter Whales and Byron Bay Surf Lifesaving Club of my entry in the 2018 Byron Bay Mitre 10 Mini Swim, consent and agree:

1. To receive such medical or other treatment which may be deemed to be advisable by the Club, its medical and first aid assistants, beach or water safety patrol personnel, in the event of injury accident and/or illness during the Byron Bay Mitre 10 Mini Swim.
2. To accept full responsibility to inform myself/ourselves and assess all the dangers hazards and risks of entry in the Byron Bay Mitre 10 Mini Swim and rely/relies solely on my/our own assessment of these dangers, hazards and risks before participating in the Byron Bay Mitre 10 Mini Swim

Swim and notwithstanding any decision thereon made by the Club and other persons, corporations and bodies involved/engaged in promoting or staging the Byron Bay Mitre 10 Mini Swim ("the Organisers").

3. To permit free use by the Club and the Organisers of my/our name and photograph in any broadcast, telecast or other media as may pertain to the Byron Bay Mitre 10 Mini Swim.
4. To have sole responsibility for my/their/our personal possessions and equipment during the Byron Bay Mitre 10 Mini Swim.
5. If, in the opinion of the surf life saving club, the weather or swimming conditions are dangerous or unsuitable, the Byron Bay Mitre 10 Mini Swim may be cancelled without notice.
6. I acknowledge and agree that should the event be cancelled or postponed at any time before the start, the course is closed; that no event support or water safety will be provided by the Club or Organisers for any person/s deciding to swim in or about the course after cancellation or postponement; that any such activity is entirely at a swimmer's own risk; and that no responsibility will be taken by the Club or the Organisers for any injury or misadventure arising from such activity.
7. That, in the event of cancellation of the Byron Bay Mitre 10 Mini Swim, my/their entry fee shall not be refundable.
8. That it is a term and condition of my/our engagement in the Byron Bay Mitre 10 Mini Swim that I/we enter at my/our own risk and such terms and conditions shall include any liability that results from breach of an express or implied warranty that the services of the Club and the Organisers will be rendered with reasonable care and skill.
9. That the terms and conditions contained in this entry form shall be construed broadly to provide a release, indemnity and waiver to the Organisers of any liability for loss injury or other damage to personal property to the maximum extent permitted by law and shall be construed according to the law of New South Wales.

Race Rules

1. All swimmers must swim the prescribed course and ensure that their name is marked off the official entrants register at the conclusion of the Byron Bay Mitre 10 Mini Swim even if they do not complete the course.
2. Swimmers must swim in the race category for which they are eligible.
3. All swimmers must wear their prescribed cap and electronic tag.
4. A swimmer may use extraneous aids, e.g. fins, snorkels or flotation clothing or devices, but such swimmers will not be eligible for any prize or qualify as an official placegetter, and must notify officials when finishing the event.
5. Any swimmer accompanying an under 15 year aged swimmer or partner will not be eligible for a prize or qualify as an official place getter and must notify officials when finishing the event.
6. All swimmers are to behave in a fair and sportsmanlike manner without interference or aggression towards other competitors and any breach of this rule may result in disqualification from the Byron Bay Mitre 10 Mini Swim.
7. If, in the opinion of an event medical officer or a water safety official, a competitor is physically or otherwise incapable of starting or completing the Byron Bay Mitre 10 Mini Swim, or has been in the water for 60 minutes, such competitor may be disqualified from starting or be removed from the water at any time.

Risk Warning (Section 5M Civil Liability Act 2002)

Warning is given to all Entrants in the Byron Bay Mitre 10 Mini Swim that there is the risk of harm to their person and/or property arising from any inadequacy of physical condition or stamina to complete the swim, hazardous sea and beach conditions including sea currents and waves and the presence of sea craft and sea creatures and other hazards.
